## Notice Regarding the Operation of Domestic Plants in March (as of February 20)

Daihatsu Motor Co., Ltd. have now decided on the following regarding operations from March onwards.

We will work closely with our suppliers and dealers and, as soon as preparations are ready, we intend to resume production and shipment of three models, including Daihatsu ROCKY (gasoline vehicle) that the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) announced on February 16 that it has lifted its instruction to suspend shipments.

We will continue to take necessary measures as instructed by MLIT, such as performing testing with the certification authorities in attendance. And we will do our best to ensure these models reach our customers as soon as possible, while reaffirming our commitment to prioritizing safety and quality.
