Notes:

- (1) In principle, on-site resident contractors, affiliated companies, and affiliated groups do not fall under the scope of Daihatsu's EMS. In such cases, the relevant managing departments seek to manage EMS-related activities and carry out any necessary communications.
- (2) Where exceptions to (1) occur, the business site in question must define and clarify the scope of EMS management on its organizational chart.
- (3) Head office divisions, engineering divisions, and other organizations that are located within certain plants but that are attached to other business sites are not subject to the EMS management of the plant in question. In such cases, the organizations are subject to the EMS management of the business sites they are attached to.
- (4) Even in cases outlined in (3), the secretariats of the business sites in question will actively communicate and share information with each other.
