Daihatsu to Strengthen Engine Manufacturing Capability in Indonesia

Daihatsu Motor Co., Ltd. (hereafter, "Daihatsu"), will extend its production line for passenger car engines at its Astra Daihatsu Motor (hereafter, "ADM"), subsidiary in Indonesia, a key overseas business location. The new production line will have an annual production capacity of 200,000 engines. The extended line is scheduled to run from the summer of 2015.

For the purposes of increasing the cost competitiveness of the engines and continuously improving their quality, engine production will be shifted in stages from the existing line to the new line. The total production capacity will not change from the current level.

By means of this extension with the leading-edge engine production line, Daihatsu will further step up its operations in Indonesia.
