New turbo engine models added to range

Daihatsu Motor Co., Ltd. has added grades with turbo engines to the Tanto mini passenger vehicle range, and will release them nationwide on December 12.

In its fully upgraded model, released in October 2013, Tanto has achieved the "Ultimate Free Space" through a further evolution in its conventionally popular usability and spaciousness, while its reliable driving performance, quietness, and thorough safety & assurance features have gained acclaim from a wide range of customers, primarily women with children. Sales are off to a good start, with over 60,000 orders as of November 30.

Daihatsu has now added turbo engine models to the Tanto. The turbo engine-equipped "Tanto X Turbo" and "Tanto X Turbo 'SA'" also feature exclusive plated grills and fog lamps to differentiate these models from the NA*1 engine models.
